



Severe Weather Policy

Brisbane City Cycling is committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy workplace for all workers (including contractors) as well as tour participants and members of the public. The tour is conducted out of doors and there are risks posed by the weather that Brisbane City Cycling is committed to minimising to as low as reasonably practicable.

In the event of any severe weather warning issued by the Bureau of Meteorology for the Brisbane Central Business District the tour will be cancelled immediately and with the issuance of a full refund to all participants (an optional reschedule option will be provided where requested).

Where inclement weather is forecast, tour participants will be contacted 24 hours before the tour and the forecast weather discussed. Tours will proceed where participants indicate they would like to do so. Refunds will be offered to all participants who elect not to proceed with the tour.

Where inclement weather occurs during the tour, the continuance of the tour will be discussed with tour participants and the wishes of the tour participants facilitated to the extent that it is reasonably practicable and with no compromise to the safety of tour participants and workers.

Brisbane is in a sub-tropical region and the heat and UV exposure can be extreme. Our tours are scheduled from April to October starting at 9am to avoid the extremes of summer. All guests will be provided water bottles and sunscreen to assist in managing this risk.
